PROJECT SUMMARY

Bayview Environmental Services completed the asbestos cable abatement at the San Onofre Power Generating Station for its Decommissioning.

This project involved several challenges including extremely stringent access requirements, additional environmental hazardous training, protocols and PPE, difficult work area access due to elevated and congested infrastructure as well as stringent COVID-19 procedures.

The scope of work consisted of the removal and packaging for disposal of 27 miles of asbestos braided cables that are found throughout the plant and included the cleaning of asbestos surface dust from the 370,000 square foot facility. The contract was valued at over \$7.7 million dollars and was completed on schedule.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Bayview Environmental Services is performing asbestos remediation for the decommissioning of a 640-megawatt electric power generating station, consisting of four conventional natural gas-fired steam units and one peaking natural gas-fired simple-cycle combustion turbine. Units 1, 2, and 5 were retired in 2003, and Units 3 and 4 in 2016. The project also includes an administration/office building, maintenance and storage buildings, chemical building, fire hose shacks, and main control rooms within Units 3 and 4.

Bayview's scope covers removal of thousands of feet of TSI piping, boiler insulation, fire bricks, and extensive transite siding and piping across the site. The project requires a large workforce and access to extremely limited areas, including work on scaffolding nearly 135 feet high and confined spaces. This assignment presents complex technical challenges that few companies in the industry can execute, and Bayview's Southern California branch is proud to serve as the selected contractor.

PROJECT SUMMARY

The demolition and abatement scope included selective and full-building demolition, removal of portable classrooms and outdated campus facilities, and preparation of existing buildings and site areas for modernization or new construction. Work may include removal of architectural, structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and site elements; disconnection and capping of utilities; salvage or protection of designated items; dust, noise, and vibration controls; and lawful disposal or recycling of demolition debris.

Hazardous-materials abatement was completed in accordance with applicable federal, state, local, and school district requirements prior to demolition or renovation activities that may disturb regulated materials. Abatement activities included identification, containment, removal, handling, transport, and disposal of materials such as asbestos-containing materials, lead-containing paint, universal waste, and other regulated building components. All abatement work was performed by properly qualified personnel using approved containment, monitoring, documentation, and clearance procedures.

It should also be noted that due to Covid-19 the projects overall schedule was severely impacted.

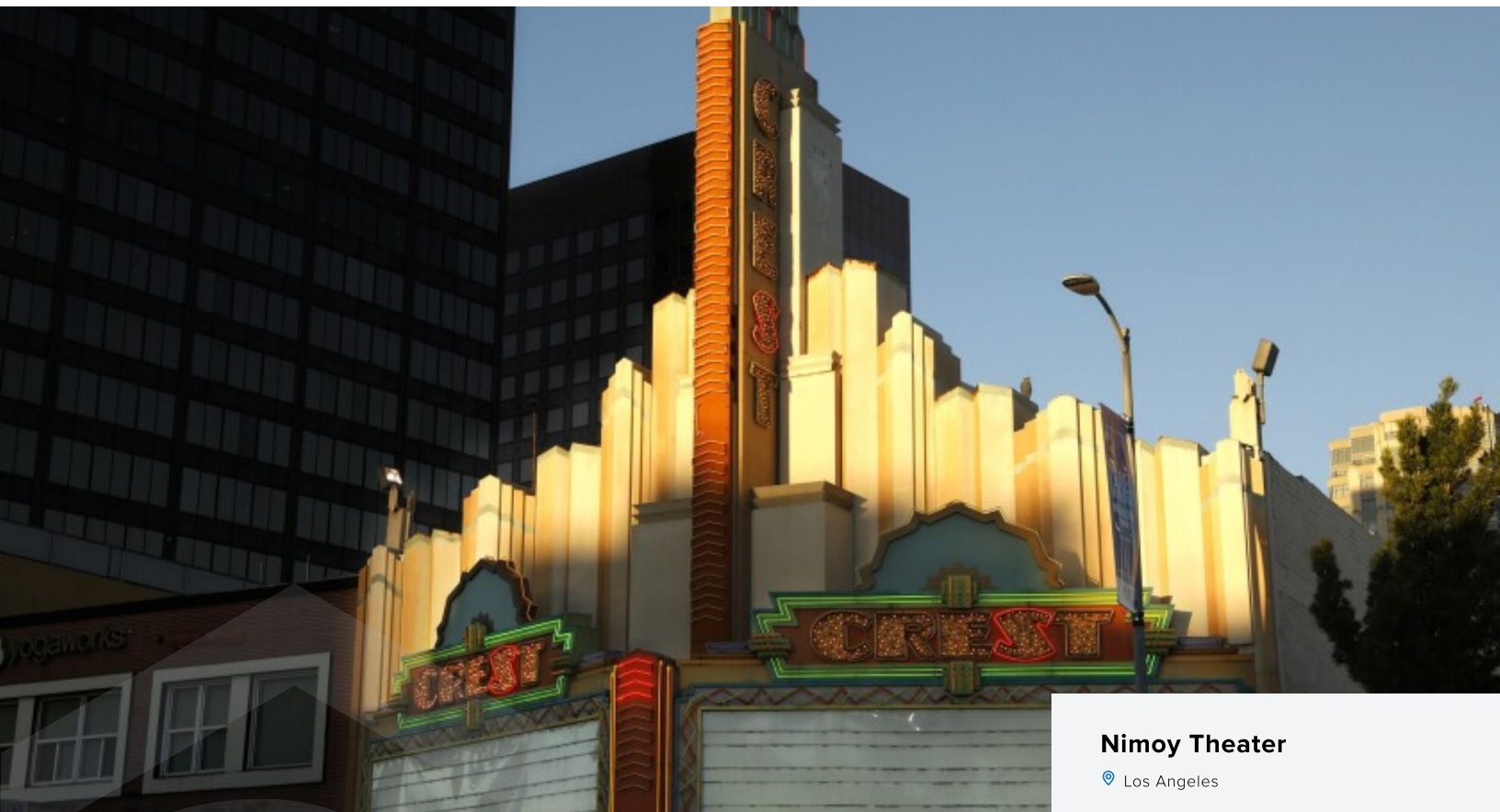

PROJECT SUMMARY

Bayview was contracted to perform extensive abatement and selective interior and exterior demolition across the project site. The abatement scope addressed VCT with black mastic, HVAC mastic, and roof parapets and penetrations, ensuring all hazardous materials were safely removed. Demolition work included removal of non-load-bearing partitions, ceilings, doors and hardware, plumbing fixtures, miscellaneous equipment, stairs and handrails, wood and concrete flooring, millwork, cabinets, shelving, floor finishes, ceramic tile, and MEP systems above first- and second-floor ceilings. The roof scope included membrane, sheathing, skylights, equipment, parapet coping, and roof openings, as well as ducting, piping, storefront crest lettering, and plaster walls. This project demonstrates Bayview's ability to efficiently manage highly complex demolition and abatement scopes while maintaining safety, quality, and project coordination.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Bayview Environmental Services, Inc. was awarded the asbestos abatement project at the California State Capitol for the remediation of the hazardous materials (asbestos & lead paint) prior to the demolition of the State Annex Building. The Annex Building is a 6- story building which was built after the Historic State Capitol Building and was built and attached directly to the back side of the State Capitol. Bayview teamed up with FERMA Corporation to provide a competitive bid to Turner Construction for the abatement and demolition of the building. FERMA Corporation was awarded the complete project and Bayview was sub-contracted under FERMA to perform the hazardous materials abatement.

The abatement included the removal and disposal of asbestos floor tile, mastic and leveling compound which was discovered on five of the six floors of the building. The scope included removing the asbestos pipe insulation and removal of loose and peeling paint prior to the demolition.

The project totaled more than 210,000 square feet of building area plus a parking garage which was located beneath the structure.

The project kicked off in January of 2022 with the Enabling work which was the preparation and separation phase of the two buildings.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Bayview Environmental Services, Inc. was awarded the mold remediation and demolition project at the Intel facility located in Santa Clara California. The scope of work was to remove moldy drywall which had impacted the entire 3 story building known as Building D2. The scope included the removal of the mechanical systems, including the main supply fans on the upper floor (Fan Deck) and all piping, electrical conduits, HVAC ducting, low voltage wiring, fire sprinkler systems, raised floors, and all interior finishes. The project was a combination project performed with Environmental and Demolition teams working in sequence to remove the necessary mechanical systems prior to the Environmental team coming in to prepare the mold containments and remove the moldy drywall materials. The \$3 million + dollar project was scheduled for 12 weeks. Several change orders were added to the contract including removal of overhead secondary steel support systems which was performed by Bayview Demolition Services, Inc.

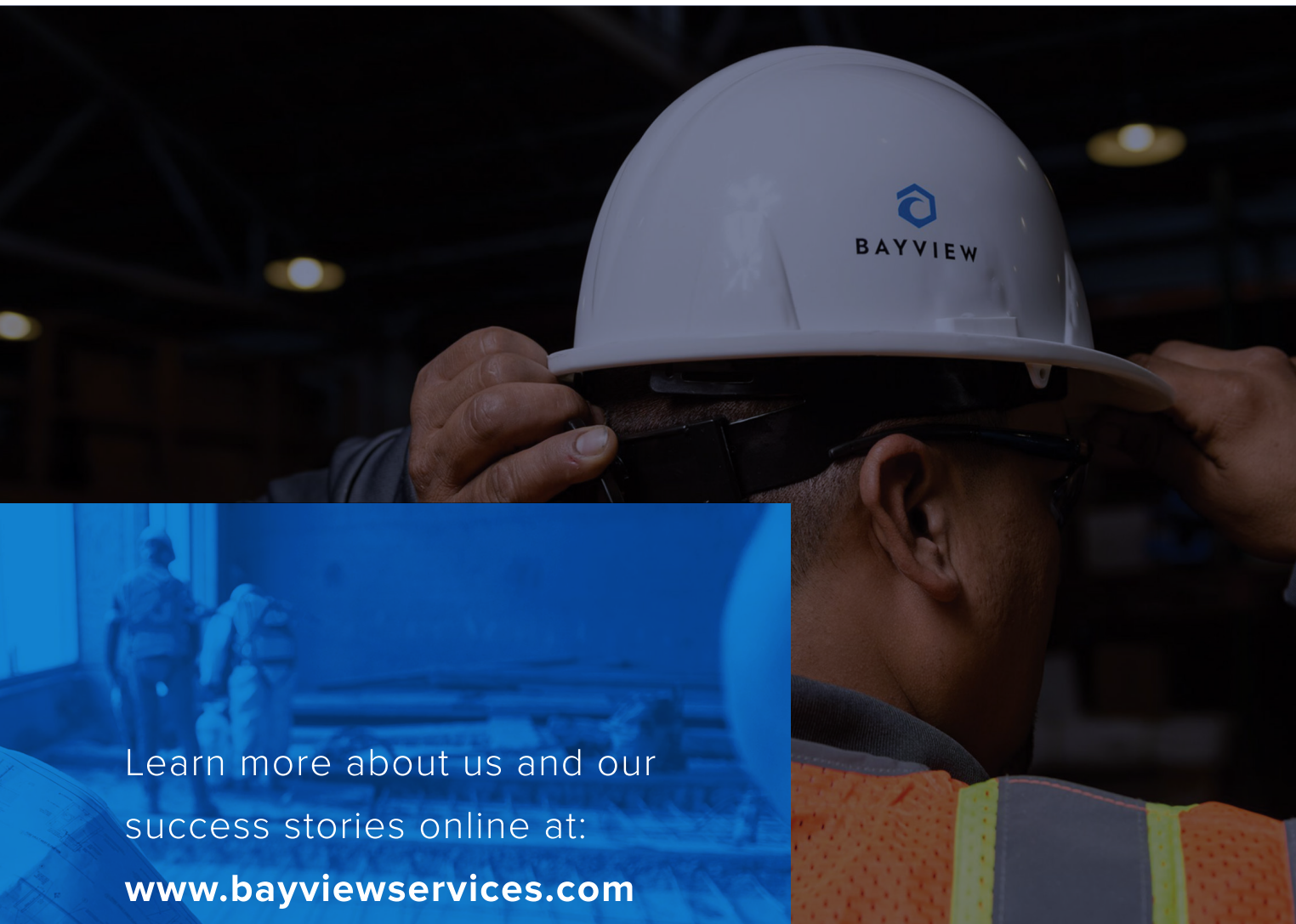
